A Napa community staple reopens downtown

Kitchen Door, Napa’s most eclectic restaurant and a longtime local’s favorite, has reopened following a yearlong hiatus in a new downtown location. The restaurant from chef Todd Humphries — of Michelin-starred Martini House fame — moved from its decade-long post at the Oxbow Public Market to Napa’s buzzing First St. Napa development. The biggest change at the new spot is that Kitchen Door has a full bar for the first time ever. There are also several new dishes on the globally-inspired comfort food menu like Vietnamese lettuce cups and fish a la plancha with truffle meunière sauce.
